Pre-recorded interview with David Paterson, CEO, Latrobe Magnesium, to talk about their plans for the magnesium production facility in Morwell. Kendall says a community meeting tomorrow will discuss plans for a magnesium production facility. He says Latrobe Magnesium intends to use fly ash from the Hazelwood Power Station to produce magnesium. Paterson says they have already started the feasibility study and the design engineering. He adds that they thought it would be best to start engaging with the community early rather than later to keep them updated with the developments. Paterson the feasibility study is expected to be completed by March next year. He shares that they have already secured a site for the facility. Paterson says they have put back their feasibility study so they can finalise finishing with CSIRO in relation with the gas requirement of the project. Paterson says they will be telling the community what their project is about, its environmental benefits for cleaning up the waste and rehabilitating the ash dams, on their meeting. He adds that they will also be discussing what the project will be bring to the valley in terms of employment and spending. Paterson says environmentally wise, they will be cleaning up the waste that has been there. He says as of the moment, they are converting about 90% of the materials into useful products. Paterson says they have identified with EPA is how to contain the dust within their area through using a technology. Kendall says the community briefing will be held at Traralgon tomorrow.
