Latrobe Magnesium has made the first major step to get a Latrobe Valley magnesium plant off the ground. The company hopes to build a plant in Morwell using waste flyash to produce up to 40 000 tonnes of magnesium annually. Cr Dale Harriman, Latrobe City Mayor explains 90% of the flyash waste from Hazelwood and the power station will be converted into a useable product. David Paterson, CEO, Latrobe Magnesium says the magnesium business is a low-emissions business. Latrobe Magnesium provided a letter of extent to the Australian Stock Exchange this week, hoping to formalise an agreement with Hazelwood Power. There are 800 direct and indirect jobs earmarked for the construction and operation of the project. The Latrobe Valley Sustainability Group has conditionally welcomed the project.
